Re: Liquor Commission Hearing of October 13, 2009, located in the Conference Room, 109 E. Olive St.

**4:00 p.m.** The application of KOS LLC., d/b/a The Teebox Bar & Grill, located at Lot 145 Airport Park Subdivision, 12<sup>th</sup> Addition, located on Gerig Dr., near the southwest corner of Gerig Dr. and Esktam Dr., requesting an RAS liquor license which would allow the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week, previously approved for Lot 132.

The removal of a stockholder for KPTS, Inc., d/b/a Six Strings, located at 525 N. Center St., currently holding a TAS liquor license which allows the sale of all types of alcohol by the glass for consumption on the premises seven (7) days a week.

Proposed text amendment, recommending the addition of another classification (SE), that would allow a business or organization to apply for a liquor license for seasonal events, lasting a specific time frame.
